



Clinic Terms and Conditions

By registering for and attending a clinic hosted by **Maryborough & District Western Performance Club Inc.** ("the Club"), all participants agree to the following Terms & Conditions.

1. Participation & Eligibility

- All riders must be physically capable of riding and handling horses safely.
 - Riders under 18 years of age must have a parent or legal guardian complete registration and sign all waivers on their behalf.
 - The Club reserves the right to refuse participation to any rider or horse deemed unsafe or unsuitable for the clinic.
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2. Horse Welfare & Suitability

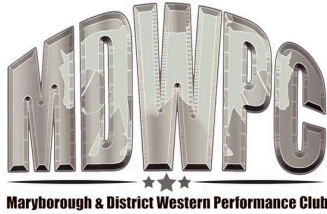
- All horses must be in good health, free from contagious disease, and fit for the level of work expected.
 - Horses showing dangerous, aggressive, or unmanageable behaviour may be excluded at the discretion of the clinician or event organiser.
 - Humane treatment of horses is expected at all times. Any mistreatment may result in immediate removal without refund.
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3. Safety & Conduct

- Riding helmets are **strongly recommended** at all times while mounted (mandatory for riders under 18 unless otherwise specified).
 - Appropriate riding attire and safe footwear must be worn.
 - Riders must follow all instructions given by the clinician, stewards, and club officials.
 - Reckless riding, unsafe behaviour, or failure to comply with directions may result in removal from the clinic.
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4. Assumption of Risk

- Horse riding and handling involves inherent risks, including injury, illness, property damage, or death.
 - By attending, participants acknowledge and accept all risks associated with horses, riding activities, and being on club grounds.
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5. Liability Waiver

To the fullest extent permitted by law, participants agree that **Maryborough & District Western Performance Club Inc**, its committee members, volunteers, clinicians, and landowners are not liable for:

- Any injury, loss, damage, or expense sustained by riders, spectators, horses, or property.
- Any incidents occurring before, during, or after the clinic, including on club grounds, parking areas, or surrounding facilities.

Participants attend and ride **entirely at their own risk**.

6. Insurance

- The Club holds public liability insurance as required.
 - This insurance does not replace personal accident, health, or horse insurance. Participants are encouraged to have their own coverage.
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7. Fees, Cancellations & Refunds

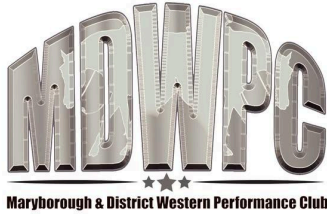
- Clinic fees must be paid in full prior to attendance unless otherwise stated.
 - Refunds will only be provided if:
 - The clinic is cancelled by the Club, or
 - A replacement rider is found (if permitted by the Club).
 - No refunds will be issued for non-attendance, withdrawal, or removal due to breach of these Terms & Conditions.
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8. Weather & Event Changes

- Clinics may proceed in varying weather conditions unless deemed unsafe.
 - The Club reserves the right to reschedule, modify, or cancel the clinic due to weather, clinician availability, or unforeseen circumstances.
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9. Property & Facilities

- Participants are responsible for any damage caused by themselves or their horses.
 - Grounds must be left clean and tidy. Manure must be managed as directed by the Club.
 - Dogs must be on leads at all times (if permitted).
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10. Media & Photography

- The Club may take photos or videos during the clinic for promotional or educational purposes.
- By attending, participants consent to the use of these images unless they notify the Club in writing prior to the event.

11. Agreement

By registering for and attending the clinic, participants confirm that they:

- Have read and understood these Terms & Conditions
- Agree to abide by all rules and instructions
- Accept full responsibility for their own safety and the welfare of their horse
